Any damage due to leakage and
any other environmental damage
must be reported immediately
to the Plant Fire Brigade (112
in emergencies or extension
3228).



The speed limit is 30 kph.
The road traffic regulations
apply.



Smoking is prohibited through-
out the entire site premises and
you are not allowed to smoke
in your vehicle! Areas in which
you may smoke are specially
marked.



You may only enter such areas
wearing safety shoes with
antistatic soles. Instead of safety
shoes you can also wear sturdy
footwear with electrostatic
discharge strips. When you
have put on the discharge strip,
it must be checked with the
tester to make sure it is working
properly.



Parking is only permitted in
spaces marked.



It is strictly prohibited to bring in
and consume alcoholic drinks or
any other intoxicating substanc-
es. Nor may site premises be
entered under the influence of
alcohol or drugs.



For your own safety and health
please wear the relevant protec-
tive equipment in working areas
marked.



Parts of the site premises
are under CCTV surveillance.



Machinery, installations and
switches must not be operated
or put into operation.



Photography is prohibited
everywhere on site premises.

You may only enter certain
buildings after checking in at
the building registration office.
Please follow the instructions
issued by Security Service at
the entrance gates.

Factory shops and rooms with an **explosive atmosphere** are marked "EX". Please bear in mind that additional regulations and rules of conduct apply. **Appliances which are not explosion-proof must not be used** in areas marked "EX" or taken into such areas.

Examples of such devices are non-explosion-proof mobile phones, cameras, motor vehicles, transport vehicles, walkie-talkies, tools, flashlights, small devices such as pocket calculators, cigarette lighters, matches, smart watches, fitness trackers and hearing aids.
