The site produces consistently high-quality custom and proprietary catalysts.

Products/uses:

- The Elyria site produces a wide variety of base-metal catalysts, both Custom and Proprietary. Primary constituents include alumina, copper, chromium, and nickel. Limited amounts of precious-metal catalysts are also produced at the site.
- Custom catalysts are developed by third-party chemical producers, whose catalyst production is outsourced to BASF on a confidential and exclusive basis.
- Proprietary catalysts are those developed and/or owned by BASF
- Most of the catalysts manufactured in Elyria are used in intermediate Petrochemical and Oleochemical processing.

Community Relations

The Elyria site maintains its relationship as a good corporate citizen within the community by meeting with community leaders and supporting local programs.
