## Products/uses:

- Clearcoat: This is the final coating layer on an automobile. It provides a clear, lustrous, and durable finish.
- Electrocoat: This is the first coating layer on an automobile. It provides corrosion protection and prepares the surface for additional coating layers.
- Resins: A variety of resins including acrylics, polyurethanes, polyesters, and epoxies are manufactured at the Greenville site. The resins are used to produce a variety of coatings for automotive (both OEM and refinish) applications.
