Ludwigshafen – January 16, 2023 – In the period from January 9, 2023 until and including January 13, 2023 a number of 190,524 shares were bought back within the framework of the share buyback program of BASF SE; on January 11, 2022, BASF SE disclosed pursuant to art. 5 para. 1 lit. a) of the Regulation (EU) no. 596/2014 and art. 2 para. 1 of the Delegated Regulation (EU) no. 2016/1052 the start of the share buyback on January 11, 2022.

The total volume of shares which have been bought back within the framework of the share buyback program in the period from January 11, 2022 until and including January 13, 2023 amounts to a number of 24,852,626 shares.
