## **Checklist at entry**

#### Valid for dangerous goods.

- **ADR Driver Training Certificate**
- T 9 Certificate for Equipment
- "Statement of Compliance for Transport of Dangerous Goods in Tank Containers / Portable Tanks"
- instructions in writing prescribed in ADR 5.4.3 in the driver's language (page 2, 3 and 4, in colour)

## Valid for dangerous goods and non-dangerous goods:

#### All Nationalities ▼

- valid EU-Driving Licence.
  - (for non-EU countries: either international driving licence or national driving licence with an officially approved German translation)
- obvious technical faults on the vehicle
- tire checks e.g. tread min. 1.6 mm
- visual checks of brake system
- visual checks of chassis, rear and side crash barriers (§ 32c StVZO) (Directive 89 / 297 / EWG)
- lights
- electrical equipment (e.g. insulation)
- visual check of the fuel tank

## only for German tractors / Trailer / Semi-Trailer

vehicle registration certificate, TÜV-Plate, SP-Plate

Valid for dangerous goods and non-dangerous goods:

Tankcontainers: condition of frame and cross frame

## <u>Curtainsider, which are not in accordance with EN 12642 Code XL standard:</u>

minimum requirements as per BASF "Requirements for LSP":

3 side planks direct above the loading surface (approx.. 450 mm high), thickness 25 mm or

1 velded continuous metal plate15 mm high

And in each case

1 side planks at the hight of the center of gravity of the cargo

Tilttrailers: all built-in brackets must be fitted with planks

Tank Trailers / Tankcontainers / Portable Tanks: outlet / blind flange (closing devices) / man-hole cover closed

# Checklist for equipment in accordance with instructions in writing (ADR 8.1.5)

- 1 wheel chock for each vehicle
- 2 self-standing warning signs
- warning vest for each member of the vehicle crew
- portable lighting apparatus for each member of the vehicle crew (shall not exhibit any metal surface liable to produce sparks)
- portable fire extinguishers prescribed in ADR 8.1.4 (e.g. at least 2 fire extinguishers with a min capacity of 12 kg, of which one with at least 6 kg)
- eye protection (e.g. protective goggles) for each member of the vehicle crew
- a pair of protective gloves for each member of the vehicle crew
- 1 eye rinsing liquid (not required for danger label numbers 1, 1.4,1.5,1.6 / 2.1, 2.2, 2.3)
- an emergency escape mask for each member of the vehicle crew (required for danger label numbers 2.3 or 6.1) with a combined gas/dust filter of the A1B1E1K1-P1 or A2B2E2K2-P2 type which is similar to that described in the EN 141 standard
- 1 shovel, 1 drain seal, 1 collecting container (required for danger label number 3, 4.1, 4.3, 8 or 9)

#### Checklist at departure

transport unit correctly labeled in accordance with GGVSEB / ADR

(ADR 5.3) (ADR 5.4.3)

Delivery notes available Vinidurlabel (product name) affixed on outlets

(BASF regulation)

transport unit clean and proper closed

weight note / gross vehicle weight within maximum weight range
